

# EDGE Europe Retreat 2018 Systems Change Philanthropy: What to do, and how to do it?

Bergerie de Villarceaux, 3 to 5 July 2018

## 1. BACKGROUND, AIMS & PRINCIPLES

In the third year of its existence in Europe, EDGE Funders Alliance has grown into a membership community of 39 foundations and individual donors from across the continent, working in different areas and parts of the world. EDGE in Europe is part of the broader EDGE Funders Alliances with almost 100 members, with the overall aim to strengthen philanthropy as actor for systemic change.

The yearly EDGE Europe retreat is an important convening to consolidate EDGE in Europe in terms of joint identity, membership, activity planning and governance. The retreat welcomes new members, integrating them in the community with the aim to strengthen EDGE as a political home for progressive foundations and a place to scale up the impact of our grantmaking.

The retreat is a safe space for in-depth discussion, learning and collaboration amongst the members on the role and challenges of philanthropy to address systemic change.

In particular, we aim to learning together and from each other, to initiate and deepen concrete collaborations, and to discuss and plan joint actions that can influence the wider philanthropic sector to address systemic alternatives and shift more resources to this cause.

The retreat will be preceded by a meeting of young Europeans with wealth or class privilege (including some EDGE members), who aim to organise for a world beyond exploitation of people and planet. For the first time, an optional "EDGE for Newbies" session will take place on the first day. That session, and the evening programme on alternative visions, will be open to members and non-members alike, before passing into the members only part of the retreat on the next day.

### 2. SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The meeting in July 2018 will bring together EDGE members and interested partners with the following objectives. Participants are invited to weight these objectives when they register:

- 1. CHANGING PHILANTHROPY Develop thinking and processes to challenge the philanthropy sector and how we address diversity, power and privilege to shift more resources towards systemic change and transformative actors
- 2. BUILDING COMMUNITY Understand individual members interests and assets for an effective joint approach, get to know each other's organisations and experiences and connect EDGE members in Europe
- 3. LEARNING Discuss and explore pressing issues regarding the role of philanthropy in systemic change
- 4. ACTION PLANNING Plan, develop and continue specific collaborations in topical working groups, strategic advocacy alliances or other collaboration formats
- 5. GOVERNANCE Improve the governance, structural rules and mandates for the EDGE European Steering Group and the development of the EDGE community in Europe



#### 3. PARTICIPANTS

The meeting is a funders only space. The first day (3 July) will be open to EDGE members and interested non-members alike, from 4 to 5 July, only European EDGE members will participate. Selected non-member foundations and philanthropic or civil society resource persons might participate upon personal invitation. Europe based EDGE staff will also participate.
